Porphyria Resources

Following assessment and discussion with the specialist porphyria service in Wales, the <u>porphyria safe list</u> will be included on the ERL. Individuals are advised to contact the <u>UK Porphyria Medicines Information Service</u> (UKPMIS) directly if the safe list does not answer their query. It is advised not to use any other porphyria resources due to the need for specialist interpretation. The UKPMIS can be contacted via 029 21842251.

Trip Database

A free version of the <u>Trip Database</u> is a good alternative to NHS evidence search and will be added to the ERL following assessment. It is advised to check the level of access locally as some Trusts offer Trip Pro advanced access which includes links to full-text articles, additional filtering, and advanced search functions (see <u>here</u> for a full list of functionality at basic and Pro level).
