### Accessing QRMG guidance and advice

### HDAS and NICE Evidence search retirement in England

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The way we are searching the literature in England is changing.

The HDAS platform and the NICE Evidence search will be decommissioned on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.

OID is now the recommended search platform.

A [guidance document, available on the UKMi FutureNHS workspace](#), has been produced explaining the changes, including how to access basic training for OVID.

HEE have no plans to replace the NICE Evidence Search. However, they have launched the NHS [Knowledge and Library Hub](#). As this service evolves, the QRMG will continue to assess its value.

### Interaction Enquiries

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**Always use at least 2 resources when handling interaction enquiries**

A poster presented at the UKMi Practice Development Seminar 2021, found that no single interaction resource has complete coverage of known interactions, with the best coverage being 70%. Therefore, at least 2 interaction resources should be used together. This consolidates previous findings from internal audits done at 2 large Regional centres. ## Resources

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### Resources for Inclusion on the Essential Resource List and Enquiry Answering Guidelines

#### ***Clinical Handbook of Psychotropic Drugs for Children and Adolescents***

This is a well-referenced resource which adds valuable information in an area which is currently lacking, and will benefit services who receive a lot of paediatric mental health queries.

#### ***SPS Medicines Supply Tool***

The monthly DHSC supply update notifications have been replaced with a dedicated Medicines Supply Tool hosted on the [SPS website](#). This free resource.

### Resources not for inclusion on the Essential Resource List and Enquiry Answering Guidelines

#### ***Vademecum Metabolicum***

This is a reliable and accurate resource, but the information is very niche and does not offer additional value above other similar resources currently recommended.

#### ***Diabetes on the Net***

Information contained within this resource is aggregated from other specialist resources already available on the internet and therefore it does not add value.

#### ***AMBOSS***

This is a subscription service aimed at American medical students. There is no additional information above what is currently available, and is not aimed at practicing professional pharmacists.

#### ***Medicines Complete Drug Monitoring Checker***

This resource is comprehensive and easy to use. However, the SPS Medicines Monitoring Tool is free and provides equivalent information, therefore the additional cost of the Medicines Complete Drug Monitoring Checker cannot be justified. This decision will be revisited in light of any future changes.

### ***Key recommendations from the latest report:***

- Enter enquiry details directly into MiDatabank at the point of receipt to ensure relevant information has been taken.
- Do not be pressurised into providing an immediate response especially where multiple resources may need to be consulted, or multiple medicines are involved.
- Use the [UKMi Guidance on Checking Enquiries](#) which includes guidance on which enquiries should be second checked.
