

Quick Guide: mi-uk via Ecompass.nl

From 14th December 2012

To register for a password

- Go to: <http://list.ecompass.nl/listserv/cgi-bin/wa?GETPW1>
- Use the email address with which you are subscribed to Maitalk and chose a password. You have to confirm registration by replying to the automatically generated email.
- The password will give you access to the list archives and to the 'join, leave or change settings' section of the website (see below)

To contact the list

To post a message on mi-uk

email: mi-uk@list.ecompass.nl

- Always put a title in the subject box.
- Use the original title if replying to a previously posted message
- Always include a signature

To contact the list owners

email: mi-uk-request@list.ecompass.nl

- Don't use their individual addresses

Posting a message to the list or contacting the list owners can also be done via the Ecompass mi-uk homepage.

Useful commands: when using these commands

- leave the email subject box blank
- signature not needed
- add two hyphens (--) on the line after the command as shown

To suspend mail

email: listserv@list.ecompass.nl
this message with no subject:
set mi-uk nomail
--

To resume mail

email: listserv@list.ecompass.nl
this message with no subject:
set mi-uk mail
--

To receive Digest mail

email: listserv@list.ecompass.nl
this message with no subject:
Set mi-uk digests
--

To stop receiving Digest mail

email: listserv@list.ecompass.nl
this message with no subject:
set mi-uk nodigests
--

- Messages are collated into one daily email
- Take care when replying to a Digest message

To leave the list

email: listserv@list.ecompass.nl
this message with no subject:
Unsubscribe mi-uk
--

Suspend and resume commands (mail delivery temporarily disabled), subscription type (regular or Digest) and leave commands can also be carried out from 'join, leave or change settings' section on the Ecompass mi-uk homepage:

mi-uk website
